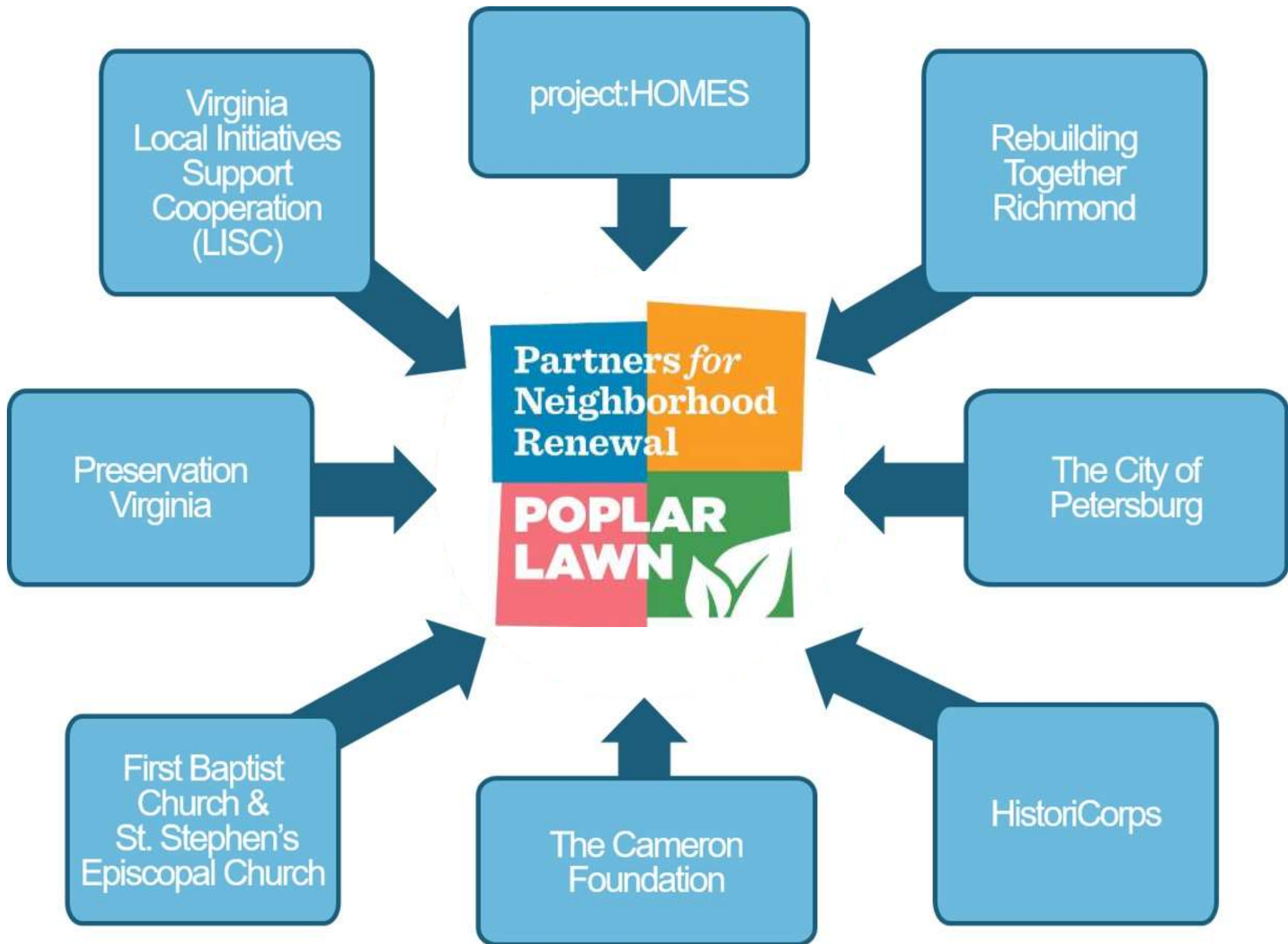
Property Usage in Poplar Lawn Historic District

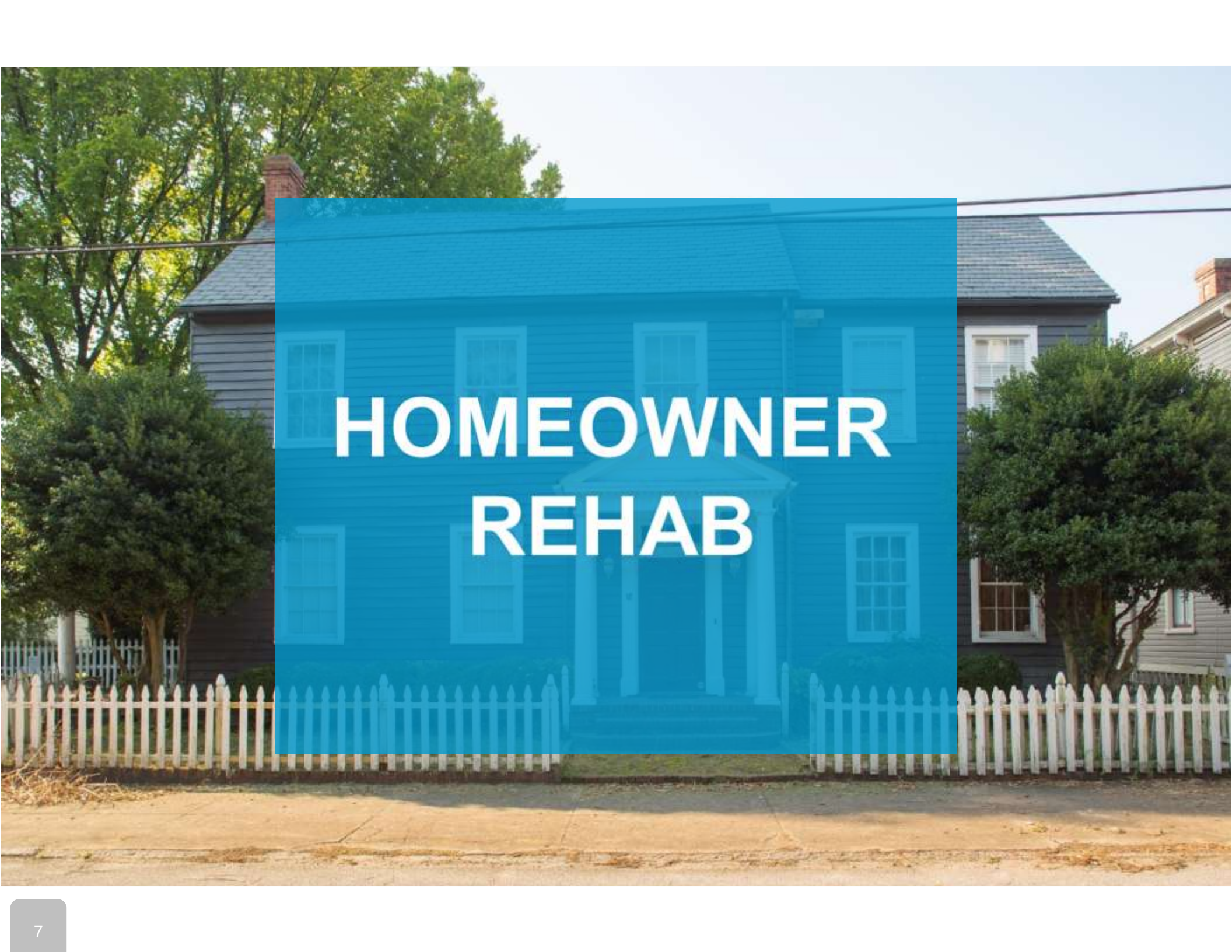

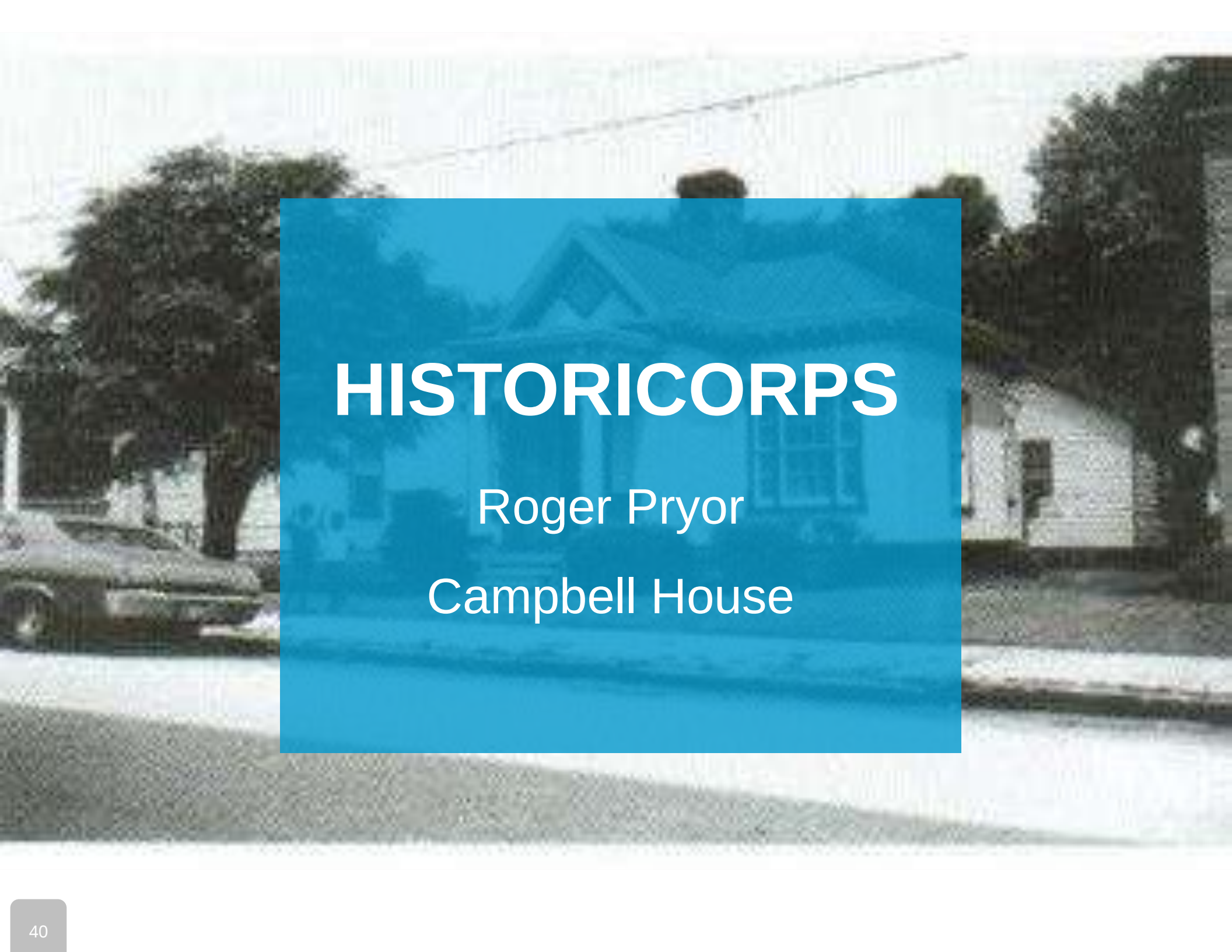
